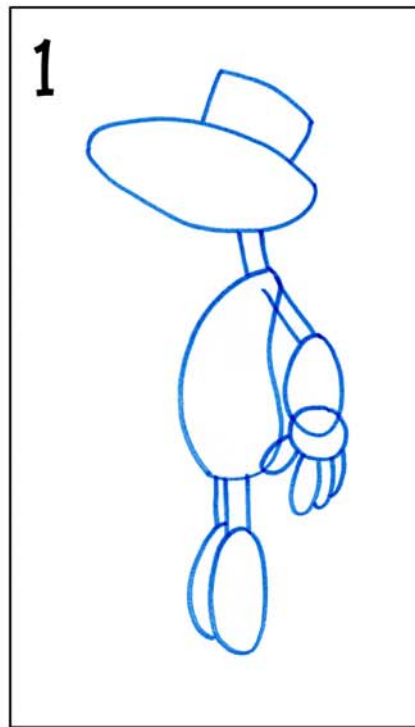
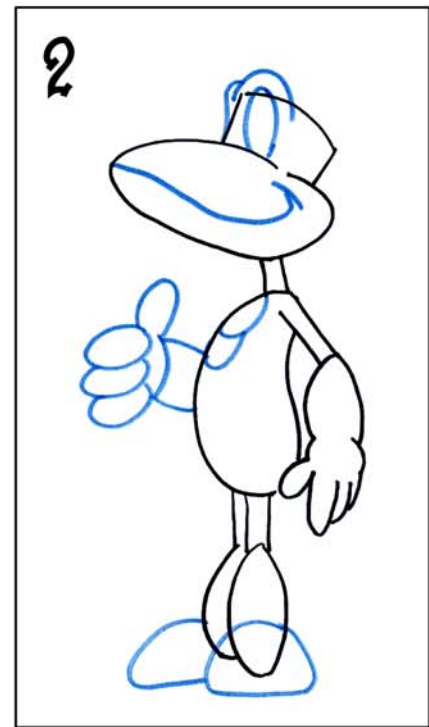


# How To Draw Rex

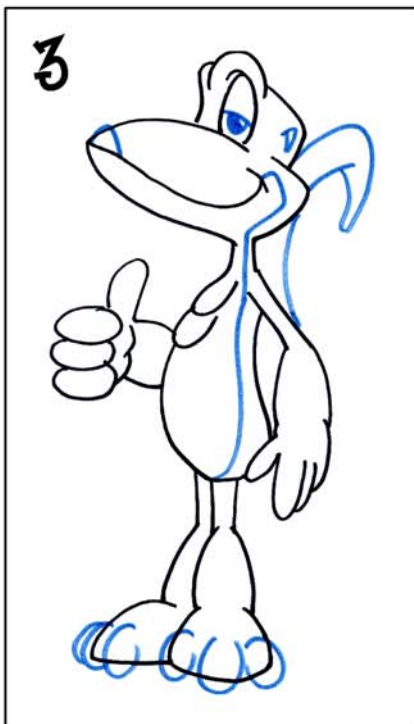
- \* Begin with a sharp pencil and a quality eraser.
- \* With each step, the blue lines represent new shapes and lines that you will need to draw.
- \* As you go through the steps, observe which lines to erase.
- \* Always remember the only way to improve is through practice.



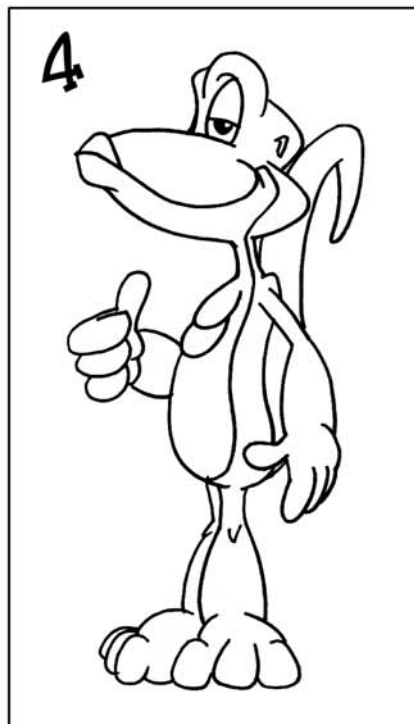
Draw the first shapes for the head, torso, left arm, hand and legs. They will overlap. You'll erase the extra lines later.



Add a right arm, right hand, eyes, and feet. Also draw details like a mouth line and lines for the dewlap (That's the flap of skin under the chin).



Draw the shapes for the toes and tail. Add lines for the underbelly, the upper lip, ear, eyelid and pupil.



Erase any lines that you don't need. Keep in mind which parts are closer and overlap the parts that are farther away.



Now enjoy coloring your work of art.
